Heavrin Named Meade County RECC president and CEO

Brandenburg, Ky. -- Kyle Heavrin will serve as the next president and Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of Meade County Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation (Meade County RECC) in Brandenburg, Ky, effective March 2, 2026. Heavrin replaces Martin W. Littrel who has served as president and CEO since 2015 and is departing to lead Blue Grass Energy located in Nicholasville, Ky.


No stranger to the area, Heavrin is a native of Breckinridge County and a former employee at Meade County RECC from 2006 until 2013, starting as an operations intern before advancing into other roles. Heavrin brings nearly two decades of diverse electric utility experience, having served in management positions at Kenergy Corp. in Owensboro, Ky., and more recently, as Vice President of Member Service at South Central Power Company, Ohio's largest electric cooperative, providing power to over 132,000 meters.

Heavrin earned a B.A. at the University of Kentucky and an MBA from Brescia University. He is a graduate of the National Rural Electric Cooperative Association's Management Internship Program (MIP) and is a Certified Key Account Executive (CKAE).

"I'm grateful to have this opportunity to come home and lead Meade County RECC during a time of a rapidly evolving and challenging energy environment," Heavrin said. "We will continue to stay focused on our goals of providing Meade County RECC members with the most affordable, reliable power that is available while investing in our community and our workforce. I'm grateful to the board and staff of Meade County RECC for giving me this opportunity and I look forward to working together for our shared goals," he said.

Meade County RECC is a member-owned electric cooperative providing power to over 31,000 meters in parts of Meade, Breckinridge, Grayson, Ohio, Hardin, and Hancock counties.
